### A BILL

To terminate the COVID-19 vaccination requirement for aliens, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATING COVID-19 VACCINATION RE-**  
4 **QUIREMENT FOR ALIENS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of the en-  
6 actment of this Act, the COVID-19 vaccination require-  
7 ment for aliens shall have no force or effect.

8 (b) PROHIBITION ON FUNDING.—Beginning on the  
9 date of the enactment of this Act, no Federal funds may

1 be used to administer, implement, or enforce the COVID–  
2 19 vaccination requirement for aliens.

3 (c) DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term “COVID–19  
4 vaccination requirement for aliens” means any require-  
5 ment of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention  
6 or the Department of Homeland Security, including pur-  
7 suant to part G of title III of the Public Health Service  
8 Act (42 U.S.C. 264 et seq.) or part 34 of subchapter C  
9 of chapter I of title 42, Code of Federal Regulations,  
10 that—

11 (1) an alien be vaccinated against COVID–19  
12 as a condition of being issued a visa or entering the  
13 United States;

14 (2) a nonimmigrant alien be vaccinated against  
15 COVID–19 as a condition of adjusting status to that  
16 of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent resi-  
17 dence; or

18 (3) an alien lawfully admitted to the United  
19 States for permanent residence be vaccinated  
20 against COVID–19 as a condition of naturalizing as  
21 a citizen of the United States.
